OLD BUSINESS

North Coast Services, LLC sent a bill for \$11.45. when questioned was told it was extra man for organization of the steel pick up. Board voted 3/3 to pay in next warrant .

Transfer Station stickers; Board chose Blue Type on white- will be ordered tomorrow.

Received a preliminary boundary survey from Leon Boucher for the beach property ONLY on Rock Haven.

Foreclosure property: Has 30 days from 7-8-13 to respond to Selectmen's letter before proceedings start to put the property out for bid.

NEW BUSINESS

Jeff made a motion to have website coordinators come in and talk to the Board about maintenance of the website, keep it updated. Board voted 3/3

ElectricityMaine- starting a new program to help communities raise money. Town would receive \$5 for each home or small business that switches their electricity to Electricity Maine. When their contracts renew, the Town will receive 2% of the electricity supply portion of their contract. The coordinator will be contacting office with more information.

Signed authorization for State surplus Property. 3/3

Speed limit sign for Spring Road denied; will have Road Commissioner grade again. 3/3

2 abatement requests denied- send letters to homeowners

Snowmobile Club- send letter to President and ask if any work will be done to the building? Painting and a new door were supposed to be completed.

Firewood at the Transfer Station- cut up and raffle or sell as is? No decision

Board voted 3/3 to purchase new signs for the Transfer Station. “No Trespassing”, STOP- See Attendant Before Dumping. And Absolutely NO picking.

Board voted 3/3 to look into purchasing camera system for Transfer Station

Motion was made that Jeremy be asked to look at the Transfer Station and see about the cost of weed wacking around the containers and the building and steel / white goods areas. Board voted 3/3.

Try to establish a traffic pattern around the containers, burn pit and C&D areas.

CEO- sent letter to landowner regarding junk vehicles in his yard. At least 2 violations were noted.

Ask Steve about the property across from the Transfer Station that burned last Fall. Have there been any permits pulled?
