NEW BUSINESS

Tom Johnson-EMA- Working on new grant for 2014. Project for next year is to purchase a tower for a unique frequency for Newfield. Location of tower is still being discussed.

Planning Board- 3 members of the board came in to discuss with the Board closing down the Town Hall for the months of December, January, February and March. Handicapped accessibility was discussed; gravel has been extended out back to the door, there is no step to get up to, the handicap sign has been put out by the side of the building. Planning Board will move one of their file cabinets down to the PSB for the duration. The Town Hall will reopen for the April planning Board meeting. Board also discussed that they would have to adhere to the 10 day to 2 week notification for hearings. The chair will be given a key for the door. A tour of the building was given by a fire member.

Paperwork for the PACE program was signed. This paperwork was not sent at the time of the vote in August of 2012.

Farmer's Market vendors have asked permission to hold the market at the Town Office . The BoS did not have an issue as long as the Market has insurance. Asked if power could be provided down to the flagpole. Board will look into the cost. Offered to clean up shrubs and replant. Laurie Lambert will donate flowers.

Jeremy Burbank- expressing interest in mowing the side of the roads next year. Requirements would include tractor with sickle bar mower, tractor registered, insured, "mower ahead" signs. There are approximately 30 miles to be mowed.

Also discussed with the Board adding weed whacking around the hydrants, transfer station and the Veterans' Park in West Newfield to the mowing contract.
