### **New Business**

Mike LaLonde- surveyor and Dean LePage – selectman from Limerick came in to discuss the Limerick/Newfield Line. Mike L. stated that a mistake had been made by not removing markers where he was surveying; the town line marker was moved and subsequently put back after Newfield questioned what was going on. Mike L. work was not a certified land survey; it was a rough idea for signage.

Limerick did pay Mike to do some research- he presented the Board with copies of the creation of Newfield in the legislature, 1846 piece of land from Shapleigh. A map from 1795 of Newfield. Mike stated he used a deed from 1822 Piper to Durgin as an overlay to the DOT plan of 1929 to see if any thing matched. It was stated that the Town Line hasn't moved; we just don't know where it is.

Selectman LePage stated that the Board in Limerick voted to not spend any more money on this project. A few options were presented to try and find the correct line. Mike L. will get estimates for 3 different options

Mike Moulton stated that the line is a rock in the River and should be considered.

Selectman Colwell feels it is their obligation to find the true line . Mike LaLonde informed the Board also that only the legislature can change a town line. Copies of what Mike copied for the Board are on file at the Town Office.

Starting May 6<sup>th</sup> the Town Office will be open during the noon hour. The Selectmen's Meeting held at the Public Safety Building will now start at 6 p.m.

CEO Sanborn stated that the dangerous buildings in question:

Symmes Pond- burned; board it up

The old Dance Hall- can be fixed

Greenwood – Shady Nook Road- needs to be taken down

Building collapse on Route 11- clean up and remove

Letters going out to owners this week.

Transfer Station- Bruce met with Jim from Atlantic Recycling regarding the moving the motors from inside the buildings to the outside to reduce noise level as requested by DEP. Also discussed using an all season oil instead of what is being used now. The squealing is caused by the heavy thick oil trying to move in the cold weather.

Was asked by the Forestry Department for permission to put a trap in the ash trees out back. Will check to make sure Town owns.

EMA Tower meeting held 3-24-14. A different site was discussed off of Mountain Road. Owner needs to be contacted,. Next meeting on 4-28-14 at 7 at the public safety building.

Need to do a road inventory to see what has been abandoned. Bruce stated that he knew Mountain Road was from Young's to what used to be Dorothy McGlincey's was abandoned. Was also asked to check and see when the last time it was voted to close certain roads for travel in the winter.

Board wants to meet with the CEO about training.

Check with Ttedto to discuss website.

Board looked at information sent by the State regarding the bridges in Town. Town's responsibility to fix railings on Goodrich and the one by Willowbros

Abatement request denied

Ask Rudy if he would like to attend the recycling Seminar in June in Manchester.
