

SelectBoard meeting

April 8, 2014

Opened with pledge at 7:25 p.m.

ONGOING BUSINESS

Board votes 3/3 to ask Limerick Board members to attend the next meeting (April 15th) to discuss the Town Line issue.

Mike LaLonde presented the Board with two estimates, one for \$800 and for one for up to \$15,000. for a certified boundary suitable for the Registry of Deeds.

Motors have been moved to the outside of containers from the transfer station attendants shed as per DEP and insurance requirements.

The Town will need a permit from DEP; Bruce stated that it would not be a problem as the possibility of the building being at the transfer station was discussed with the DEP and they were in agreement should it get voted in

Place ad in the paper for LABOR ONLY 24x24 building 6 12' pitch- vinyl sided Liability insurance and worker's comp required. Bids to be in by April 28th and will be opened at the April 29th meeting at 7 p.m. at the Public Safety Building. The materials list is available at the Town Office.

The Building Committee will meet on May 5th at 6:30 p.m. at the transfer station for a site walk for placement of recycling building. Regular meeting to follow at 7 at the Public Safety Building.

Bruce discussed what the Fire Marshal will want to see fixed at the Town Hall; exit signs, hard wire smoke alarms up and downstairs, hand rails at stage, handrails on outside stairs 40" high; sprinkler over furnace; fire door downstairs. Hall closed until inspection and requirements finished.
