- 6:00 - Call to Order by Board Member, Jeffrey Cuevas
- Open meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance
- Sign A/P and payroll warrant
- Sign previous meeting minutes

NEW BUSINESS

- Wade Andrews-ACO- attended meeting and handed in work sheets. He indicated that it has really not been very busy. He also explained there are new rules with regard to dangerous and nuisance dogs. Dogs that are deemed this way by the court have stricter fines and license fees. Wade asked about impound fees for dogs. For instance if Wade picks up a dog and the owner contacts him prior to bringing to shelter there is no fee currently to the owner. Nichole to look into-both Limerick and Waterboro have an ordinance. Wade will work on a list of supplies needed to purchase for the upcoming budget.
- Jim mentioned only using salt on the steps at town hall to save the floor from wear. Nichole checked with Clint he indicated that it is \$0.50 per square foot. He can do two coats on whole thing or just two coats on high traffic area. Board now has a figure to budget.
- Nichole met with representative from Kyocera about a new photocopier lease. Ours is set to expire soon. The price for the machine would actually decrease from our current lease. Jim asked to get the price for what it would be to purchase the current machine. Nichole to check and will discuss at next meeting.
- Martha Morrison-SMRPDC Rep- provided a memo to Board regarding a meeting they had about transportation for the elderly.


OLD BUSINESS

- PSB Roof update- Jeff met with contractor. They have tried a few options which have not worked. They have a couple of more things to try and if it does not work they will spray (paint) the building but not until spring. They will also re-shingle the overhand. The company asked if we could send funds for the warranty. Jeff and Jim agreed.
- PSB paving- Jeff spoke to company and they are looking to complete the work in the next week or so.
- Jim mentioned the military truck the Fire Department received. Where will it be stored for winter and have they completed the requirements within the six months.
- Discussion on the fork truck. Jim and Jeff both agreed that a backhoe would be more along the lines of what the transfer station needs.
- Reminder that the Veteran's ceremony is on the 11<sup>th</sup> (Sunday) at 11.
- Jim mentioned getting the honor roll sign back. Jeff to contact the person who has it.
- Margaret and Richard Harriman came to discuss the letter they had received regarding not plowing from 136 Stevens Corner Road to their driveway at 125 Stevens Corner Road. Margaret explained that they do not agree with the 2009 vote, they believe this to be a clerical error. The road is actually named from their homestead. They are asking the Board and town to correct the clerical error. They have been paying taxes in town for 3 years and many years before that all within York County. They have lived in York County since 1998. When they purchased the home their realtor indicated the road was town maintained and since they have purchased it the town has always plowed to their driveway. Nichole explained that looking back at the votes from 1971, 1981, 1991 and again in 2009 to vote of the townspeople was to close the road to winter maintenance from 136 Stevens Corner Road (Bucks). The Harriman's indicated that they would seek legal action. Jeff explained that is their decision. Jeff and Jim indicated that they would like to discuss with Shelly the options. Margaret

asked about plowing anything over 6". Jim touched on the late notification and indicated that this was brought to the Boards attention last meeting. The Harriman's indicated that they are not fighters but will stand up for something they believe in. Richard explained that this problem really arose due to the status of the rest of the road being abandoned and the snow pile being left there. He indicated that the washout on the road is not from the snow pile but the many tributaries running down the mountain and also Tracy's swamp. Nichole to check into whether the Harriman's can petition the town to open the road up to year round maintenance and if we would have to wait until after April 30<sup>th</sup> as to affected the winter maintenance of the road.

- W/f quote for cameras at the transfer station.
- Dave Neville came in at the end of the meeting. The Board mentioned that the vent covers and the holes at the PSB need to be done. Dave indicated they would do them. Jim asked about the military truck. Bertha is going to go to the old fire station and the Military truck will be moved in. Dave mentioned that Derek still plans on getting the railing done at the PSB. Dave indicated that there is a problem with mice. Board asked about budgets for the coming year. Dave indicated that as of 12/31/18 he will no longer be fire chief. Once he is retired as chief he plans on siding the diesel building. Dave indicated that he will be attending the budget meeting for dispatch at 6pm in Alfred. The fire department likes the new street light. Nichole to contact CMP rep. to see if they will turn light more towards driveway entrance.


