
- 6:00 - Call to Order by Chair, Shelly Gobeille

NEW BUSINESS

- Nick and John were in to discuss the Rescue budget and call reports. The Rescue's budget was tight this year- in the black by a couple thousand dollars. They have decided to keep their budget the same this year as last. \$15K for Ambulance, \$22K for general operation, and \$52,500 for 7 day a week daytime staffing. They indicated they would have one warrant article to cover the \$18K for weekend and \$34,500 for weekday. They are talking about whether it is necessary to keep two ambulances in service. When the second ambulance was added mutual aid was almost non-existent; now mutual aid is very reliable given the other towns have staffing. Two ambulances at the same time were only used 6 times this past year.
- Jason Neville was in to discuss Fire department budget. They have decided to hold their budget at \$34,500.00. No funds for the fire truck fund this year as we still have one payment on the SCBA loan left.
- Board received a plowing complaint from Eric Cleveland regarding pushing all the snow onto his side of the road. Board discussed that Eric's driveway is the side that the wing is on. This means more of the snow is pushed o his side of the road. The banking's were also pushed back to plan for any storms coming in the future-making room.
- There is a tax lien training offered in Portland that Nichole and Justine could attend to take care of the every other year training. Shelly made a motion for Nichole and Justine to attend the training ion April 18th. Jeff seconded. No discussion. Vote unanimous-3 in favor.
- Board went over budget articles in preparation of Finance Meeting on February 12th.
