

NEW BUSINESS


- Review of Special Town Meeting on Saturday. Dog Ordinance passed as in effect. Wade was there. Impounding fee can now be charged. Closing of roads to winter maintenance article passed. The two roads (portions) listed are South Effingham and Spring Road. Stone Rd. (portion), Mountain Rd. (portion), Whitehouse Rd (portion). and Stevens Corner Road (portion) were not listed on the current order. The old order expired on 7/29/2019 which these roads were previously listed on. All these roads were not listed for various reasons previously discussed at the public hearing prior to the special town meeting. The portion of Whitehouse Road will now need to be plowed by the town, but the Board would like to find out from the townspeople their intention with this road- whether they want to keep it or turn it back over to the abutters. 2 abutters' letters would be mailed to accomplish this and then the 1 year time frame starts and then it would go to a town vote. Ken indicated this was discussed to start this process after the winter closing was voted on. Ken made a motion to put forth an order to discontinue that portion of the Whitehouse Road and mail the abutters their letters which starts the year long wait timeframe. Jim seconded. No discussion. 3 in favor. With regards to plowing this section of the road this year; Nichole spoke to Casey who indicated that he does not want to plow it. Jon Morrill already plows the other section of the road so the Board would like to check with him. Shelly mentioned how the road should be listed on the discontinuation notice. Nichole thought Whitehouse Road formerly known as Jones Road, Nichole to check with Leah.
- Wayne LaValley was in to discuss with the Board the possibility of setting up a hot dog stand at Rock Haven Town Beach. It would be a propane steam table on wheels. Shelly asked if Wayne had looked into the State licenses required for this. She mentioned a vendor license and safe food handling. Jim indicated that "IF" they allowed it they would need to come up with some sort of guidelines. Shelly would like Leah's opinion. Wayne to check into state licenses. Wayne will be back for next meeting on the 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:15pm.
- Sarah Trask- received email from Sarah. Shelly read email aloud. Regarding high speed internet on Spring Road. She will be working from home and is not able to get high speed internet due to a gap in the pole lines of ¼ mile. The Spring Road electricity coming from Elm Street stops at 185 Spring Road. The property at 266 Spring Road-the next house gets their power as well as the rest of Spring Road from Parsonsfield. Nichole to contact CMP, Metrocast and Parsonsfield about whether Spectrum goes down Benson Road.
- TS Bottles and metal- good feedback about JMS for the bottles and Freon. Numbers look good. They indicated they would also be interested in aluminum and metal. We could pile it up and not need a container and charge no haul fee just would split profits with us. This would save harry time not having to strip clean metal. Ken will research and bring back when have info. Jim indicated that he did not like the mess of the "metal pile" in the past; he would request piles to be picked up frequently. Ken said he is keeping everyone in the look. Shelly expressed wanting to see the numbers.
- Jim Campbell asked if they would approve 3 people at the TS until December. All 3 BOS indicated it was not necessary. Jim said maybe a couple weeks more to prepare for winter. Jim Campbell's last day will be 10/13/2019.

- Swap shop will close Columbus Day weekend-Oct 13<sup>th</sup>. Denise and Jim Campbell will come in before Transfer Station opens on 10/16 and clean it out for the winter.
- Peter asked about ceiling tiles in old Town Hall kitchen. They are falling down. Board said to rip them out and get rid of them.
- Casey met with Crane Company. The tree in the cemetery on Stevens Corner Road will cost \$3000 and is a huge deal to access. Shelly mentioned maybe Arnold?
- RSU 57 sent letter about items for sale school buses and GMC Savannahs. Board indicated they are not interested.
- Jim asked about the Fire Department forestry truck. Shelly said that he should check with the Fire Department about it.
- School Board meets tomorrow.
- Nichole to contact Luke at Mousam Valley Tech for furnace cleanings at Town Hall, Town Office and PSB.
- MMA convention. Shelly not able to go. Kenny is going. October 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Nichole to register Kenny and book hotel.
- Salt and Sand Building. Nichole contacted state and is waiting for survey.
- Maplewood Cemetery. Nichole found information referencing the lots. Nichole to contact Association and try and find out more information.
- Town office fascia/trim boards need to be replaced. Town Hall faucet needs to be replaced in what was the ladies room. Wires to be run at the town office.
- Shelly looking into poles for the new sign at the town office. Shelly says two poles will work.
