- Open meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance

**NEW BUSINESS**

- EMA- Rob Elliot- came to give an update to the board. Right now, York County is the most infectious in Maine with COVID. They will be setting up a vaccination site at the old Marshalls in Sanford and are looking right now for traffic control and intake people. As Rob knows more, he will get it out to the residents via social media pages. The Board should be informed as to what is going on if they receive the daily update email from MEMA.
- Chris Snowdeal provided the Board with preliminary plans for review and some pricing. The Board requested a larger entrance as the one on the drawing does not look like it will work with traffic flow. With rear loading entrance estimated \$689K without rear entrance \$629K
- Norm provided the Board with a report of the money that he has taken in this past year. He suggested of increasing the electrical fees. Plumbing fees could also be increased, and state would still only get 25% of what they charge. Norm indicated he has been putting in between 14 and 20 hours per week. Board asked Norm to follow up on Marina CUP application amendment for the Planning Board.
- Town Hall damage- looks as if someone backed into the Town Hall foundation pushing in some of the cement blocks.


**OLD BUSINESS**
