- 6:00 - Call to Order by Chair, Shelly Gobeille
- Open meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance

NEW BUSINESS

- The Town Office will be closed for one week due to 3 positive Covid cases. Limerick has been approved to run motor vehicle and IFW transactions. The plan will be to open the office back up on Wednesday the 14th at noon.
- Recycling Center (Swap Shop)- Jim suggested that everything that is touched would have to be cleaned and re-sanitized. Ken expressed having no heartburn opening back up if strict adherence to guidelines. At the next meeting (April 20th) the Board would like to discuss ideas. Gloria said that the CDC guidelines have been lowered as well.
- The Board met with Arnold and walked the property and talked to him about select cutting. They spoke to him about where the driveway would be for the sand and salt building, and he did not see an issue with the location just that is should be a separate entrance. Arnold would like to get the topographical information from the engineer. Shelly to contact Chris and have him send her what they have. Where the building would go is pretty much staked off so he can see that. This will allow us to see what we are working with.
- Deadlines for June vote ballot questions is fast approaching. The school is having a budget meeting next Wednesday. Shelly will be attending. Ken asked if the meeting was being zoomed. Shelly said that she was not sure but would record it with her phone. Jim is hopeful to attend. It is being held at the Massabesic East Building. Shelly mentioned getting the figures together for next meeting to have a vote on the financing of the sand and salt building. Nichole to reach out to Tax exempt leasing but also see if there is another company that offers a better interest rate. Shelly asked Gloria if the planning board would have anything for the June vote. Gloria said they may have something but with having to hold public hearings they are probably looking more for town meeting.
- Shelly asked how Nichole was doing at the office while the others are recovery. Nichole explained that everything is getting done. Nichole asked about Norm and when he is coming to office so she can tell people who are calling because they are having a hard time getting a hold of him. Shelly has a meeting with Norm on Thursday and will ask him how to handle permits being dropped off.

OLD BUSINESS

- Shelly would like to get things going on the Town Office Security Cameras, we have received 2 quotes- one costing about half of the other. Shelly made a motion to accept the bid from Chris Gimenez bid for security cameras at the town office. Ken seconded. Discussion: Jim asked how many cameras- Shelly said 7- 6 on the exterior of the building and 1 inside in the hallway pointing out at the door. Nichole added that the system is expandable up to 16 cameras. There will be a tv screen inside. Roll call vote- Ken (yes), Jim (OK), Shelly (yes). Shelly will let Chris know.
- Gloria let the Board know that they have a zoom meeting scheduled with Office of Marijuana policy and requested Norm's attendance based on the town having two large grow operations. Gloria is concerned that he will not be able to speak as was the case with the last meeting and he had technological issues. Shelly will speak to Norm about either attending the meeting in person or using zoom from his officer camera as that is working correctly.
- Heating system- Jim will speak to Shawn Carroll about coming in for the next meeting.
- PB storage area. Gloria will determine some options. It is not practical for the tables, chairs, computer, and tv to be moved each meeting for safe keeping. Rather to have a permanent storage area that locks.
- Ken will ask for Derek to put the cement barriers back in place as all the snow has disappeared.

- Board will be working on the plowing contract for the municipal buildings. The plow contracts for town roads is due back the 29th and set to be opened on May 4th.
- Board will work on fee schedule next workshop and meeting.
- Casey will follow up with Gorham Fence about guardrail repair on Spring/Benson.


